

Directions to the Demonstration

There's a 12:33 train from Hoboken (or from other towns along Main line in NJ) to Paterson that arrives 1:05. The meeting point (at St John's Cathedral opposite the Jail) is two long blocks west of the station along Market Street (direction Main Street) and about two blocks south from there (direction Grand Street). I'd say 10 minutes walk.

(Going back there's a 1:43 and a 2:43. Roundtrip is 7.50 from Hoboken.)

Hoboken is accessible via PATH from NYC.

NJ Transit buses #72, 74, 75 all stop in Paterson, virtually in front of the jail and cathedral. I think the 190, 702, 704, and several others may stop there or nearby. Please check the [njtransit](http://njtransit.com) website for the most convenient bus for you.

There is a Paterson/New York direct jitney (small bus) service that runs frequently (on Sunday maybe every 15 minutes?) from the corner of 41st St and 8th Ave, opposite the Port Authority terminal, takes you through the metro towns in between, and stops right in front of the cathedral at Grand and Main. It takes about 50-55 minutes and unless they've raised the price costs 4.00 each way.
